# **WORKBC WAGE SUBSIDY PROGRAM**

The WorkBC Wage Subsidy program covers a part of employee wages so employers can hire job seekers and provide work opportunities. Both unemployed individuals and employers in B.C. can benefit from the WorkBC Wage Subsidy. To be eligible, you have to meet certain criteria including being a registered business in BC and compliant with all applicable legislation. The good news is that recent changes mean that employers can apply for subsidies in 2 ways - either on your own on-line or by connecting with us. If you have a candidate for a job you can apply for the wage subsidy online at workbc.ca. If you have a job but no candidate, connect with us to be matched to a suitable job seeker. Subsidy rates range, depending on an individual's situation. You can contact us in New Westminster to discuss the wage subsidy program with our Work Experience Specialist.
